



FACTS AND FIGURES: ROHINGYA 2017

Aid in numbers

- Amount donated since 2017: **CHF 11,766,433**
- Amount donated since the 23 May 2018 fundraising day: **CHF 7,247,101**
- Amount spent on or allocated to projects (mid-November 2019): **CHF 10,827,255**
- Number of projects carried out: **24**

According to the UN, since late August 2017, over 740,000 people of the Rohingya ethnic minority have fled Rakhine State in north-western Myanmar and sought refuge in Bangladesh. Witnesses have described scenes of unprecedented armed violence and villages burned to the ground. Distressed by a highly difficult exile, they are cohabiting in the world's largest refugee camp with around 200,000 other Rohingyas who preceded them.

What happens with your donations?

Thanks to your donations, our partner NGOs carry out projects that respond to the specific needs of these people, who are also affected by the monsoon season's destructive weather:

- They treat sick and injured people
- They dispense nutritional support to people suffering from undernourishment, to pregnant or breastfeeding women, and to children
- They build wells to provide the Rohingya with safe drinking water
- They distribute household items and materials to repair shelters or build new ones
- They reinforce shelters and build or reinforce latrines and wells to protect the Rohingya from monsoon floods
- They provide training on market gardening techniques to enable people to grow vegetables on the walls and roofs of shelters, and they plant fruit trees
- They distribute rubbish bins and remove waste to improve quality of life in the camp
- They protect children from exploitation and abuse and help people of all ages overcome their traumas
- They provide practical information on the services available at the camp and on health and protection
- They raise awareness about women's rights and signal abuses
- They care for children separated from their parents as they fled
